

### Swimming Report and Data

We started with only 1-year group but have used the premium to increase provision. Now children go swimming for a term in Y3,4 and 5 and we also have a focus group of Y6 children who were close to meeting the objectives attending an extra session a week. This is very beneficial for many of our children who do not have much experience of swimming and has made a huge difference to attainment as can be seen in the table below.
