Schools will thoroughly review their health and safety risk assessments and draw up plans for the autumn term that address any risks. We will now be preparing to welcome 30 children in each class this September.

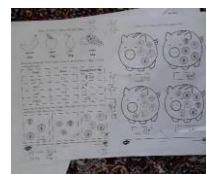

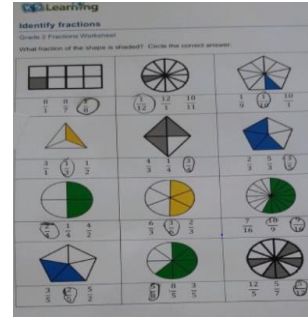

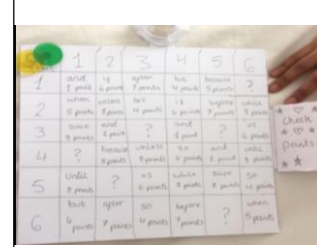
