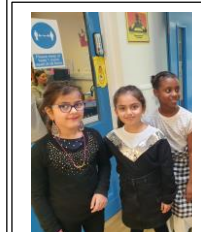

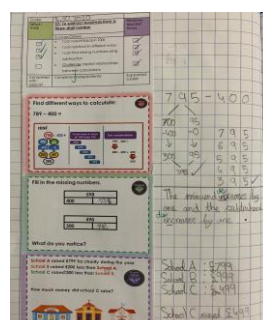
Reading

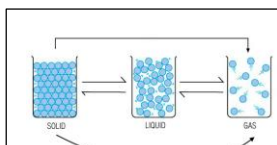
Maths. We love TTRS and complete at least 3 sessions each week. Our teachers say we are really improving!

Science. We have been learning about the states of matter and acting out the movements of particles in solids, liquids and gas.

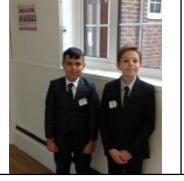
