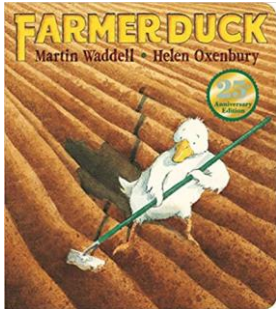

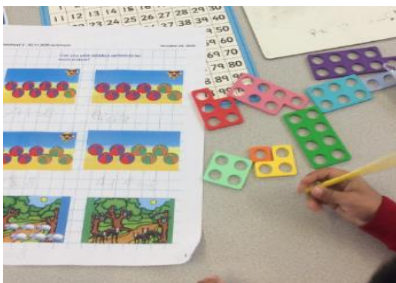
Reading

We have been reading books in our groups. We learnt to make predictions and identify the characters. We talked about what happen in the story and are beginning to answer questions about the story.



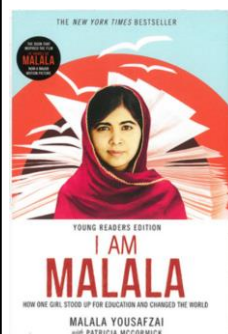
Maths.
