My name is Ms Cyrus and I am currently an Assistant Headteacher, Year 3 teacher (Opal class) and Phase Lead for Lower Key Stage 2.

I have always wanted to teach, even at a young age but did not follow this

vocation until I was older. I trained to be a teacher after working as a Teaching Assistant at my children's school. Prior to that, I worked as an accounts clerk at a haulage contractor (3 years) and a clerical officer at British Telecom (13 years) and while at university, I worked at one of the Credit Union Branch (Peckham) as a credit controller and a teller.

I have been teaching for 21 years. I qualified as a teacher from Roehampton University (BA/QTS) in 2000 and my first teaching post was at a one form entry school in Wandsworth (Christ Church Primary). I stayed there for seven years and taught Reception, year 1 and year 2 and cover teacher for year 3 and 4. Thereafter, I joined the Ark Schools and worked at King Solomon Academy for 5 years. While working there, I worked as a year 1 and 2 teacher, I completed the threshold and became a middle leader and phase leader. I left Ark to develop my pedagogy and went to work in an outer London school called Darrick Wood Junior in Orpington as a phase leader and Year 1 teacher.

Thereafter, because I have the certificate to teach in Catholic schools, I returned to work in an Inner London Catholic school (English Martyrs) as a year 5 teacher. This was a nostalgic move for me as this was the school that my children went to in Southwark. When I left there, I went to teach in Islington again as a year 5 teacher and phase leader for year 5/6. After that, I worked at Chobham Academy which is part of the Harris Academies, and taught year 3 (Phase Leader), 5 and 6.

I have been at Braintcroft for the past three years. I cannot see myself doing any other job as I love working with children and being part of their success stories.

As a member of the Braintcroft team, we share a passion which is embedded in our SPIRIT values. We consistently look for success in everything we as teachers do and what the children do. We celebrate and embrace our different cultures to work as one – a family.
