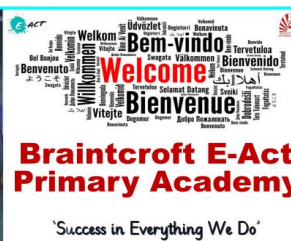
We are taking all precautions to ensure that everyone stays healthy and safe in our school. We are insisting that if pupils have Covid symptoms they should stay at home and get tested.
