TIK TOK AND OTHER SOCIAL MEDIA PLATFORMS.

I am writing to inform you of some concerns regarding social media, specifically the platform Tik Tok.

Please take the time to regularly monitor your child's phone, internet devices and any social media accounts that they may have, as they are not at the legal age to hold some of these accounts. It has come to our attention that some of our children are sharing videos with people they do not know.

What is TikTok?

TikTok (formerly Musical.ly) is a free social media platform for creating and watching short videos and sharing them with friends and strangers. Clips are often created using music and can be enhanced by a range of tools such as filters, animation and special effects and have now become quite popular with adults, teens and children.

Parents must be vigilant in how their child access social media. There have already been several concerns raised regarding the existence of Tik Tok. However, due to videos seen recently of our pupils posted publicly, we have been holding a series of assemblies to remind our students of internet safety measures.

Please support us in monitoring your children on their devices at home.






















Dear parents and carers,
