TURQUOISE: Mariam, Bushra for doing very well in Phonics.

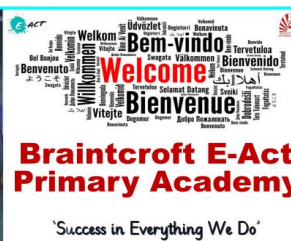
Year 2: **CRYSTAL:** Hadidha, **ONYX:** Parisha, Sidal, **SAPPHIRE:** Max and Amaya

HOW TO ADDRESS WHAT IS HAPPENING IN UKRAINE WITH YOUR CHILD!



PEACE AND CONFLICT is one of our Global themes in our curriculum. Our pupils are encouraged to see the rewards of having peace in the world and the dangers that can arise when there is conflict. we stand for peace.

Working together brings Peace.



Talk about what they're seeing on the news. Talk to your children about what they might be reading online about the conflict in Ukraine – make them aware that there is a lot of fake news and misreporting, and that while it's important to engage with the reality for people in Ukraine, looking at graphic images could impact them. Consider limiting their exposure. As many of our families are from war torn countries, they may empathise with what is happening to families who are running away from Ukraine. We encourage pupils to speak to us at school about any aspect of this matter that affects them. Even without a direct personal connection to the conflict, it's natural that seeing all the footage coming out of Ukraine, whether on the news or on social media, can be distressing. It's important to recognise this, even if we are committed to paying attention, showing solidarity, or seeking to help the victims.
