Who was Stephen Lawrence? Stephen Lawrence was a black teenager who lived in Eltham in South London.

On 22 April 1993, Stephen was killed by a gang of white men in a racist attack. He had been waiting for a bus with a friend, when the gang attacked them. Stephen's friend escaped unhurt, but Stephen died from his injuries. Our children from year 6 did an assembly to inform pupils about this event and the racial injustices his family faced after his death.
