## FASTING DURING RAMADAN AT BRAINTCROFT

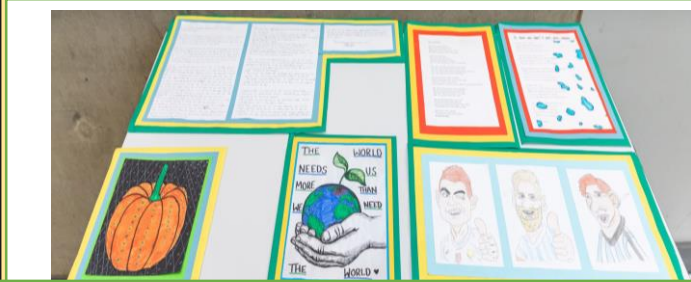
