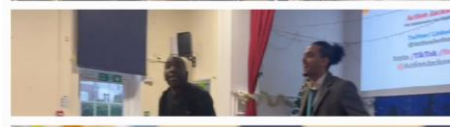
WE ARE AIMING FOR OUTSTANDING!
