KS2 SATs will take place between Tuesday 9th May 2023 – Friday 12th May 2023. Over this period pupils will sit 6 different tests, with English normally taking place at the beginning of the week and maths at the end. We will provide FREE BREAKFAST for all Year 6 pupils during their SATs week. Please ensure that they are all at school for 8:00 am breakfast. Please continue to put the effort in, attend school every day, read and revise as you will appreciate the results of your hard work.
